Subject: Deposit and Fee Schedule Update

### **Background:**

Shasta LAFCO policy establishes a schedule of fees and charges for application and other expenses beyond those in the annual budget. Changes to establish updated fees and charges, according to California Government Code § 66016, Shasta LAFCO has published notice of public hearing for October 6, 2022.

### **Discussion:**

There was a previous fee schedule update in 2020. A proposed Deposit and Fee Schedule 2022 update (Attachment 1) provides a change in verbiage, additions of out of service area and time extension fees and format changes. Deposits are held, and increased as necessary, until application completion. All costs are then accounted for, and any unexpended funds are returned to applicant or additional fees invoiced if the actual costs exceed the deposit.

### Recommendation:

Staff is recommending approval of the updated Deposit and Fee Schedule via Resolution 2022-16 or provide staff with further direction.
