
Figure 11: Sphere of Influence



SHASTA LAFCO RESOLUTION 2022-17

RESOLUTION OF THE SHASTA LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION ADOPTING THE MUNICIPAL SERVICE REVIEW & SPHERE OF INFLUENCE UPDATE OF THE CITY OF REDDING

WHEREAS, the Cortese Knox Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000 governs the organization and reorganization of cities and special districts by Local Agency Formation Commissions established in each county, as defined and specified in Government Code Sections 56000 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Shasta Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO), hereinafter referred to as the "Commission", is authorized to conduct Municipal Service Reviews (MSR) and establish, amend, and update Spheres of Influence (SOI) for local governmental agencies whose jurisdictions are within Shasta County; and

WHEREAS, The MSR/SOI update is for the City of Redding; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer prepared a MSR for the City of Redding, and a proposed SOI update recommendation based upon this analysis pursuant to California Code Section 56430; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer prepared a MSR for the City of Redding, and a proposed SOI update recommendation based upon this analysis pursuant to California Code Section 56430; and

WHEREAS, in the accordance with California Government Code Section 56661, the Executive Officer has given sufficient notice of the public hearing by the Commission on the proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer has presented to the Commission, a written staff report with recommendation on the proposal in the manner provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the Commission heard and fully considered all testimony and evidence presented at a public hearing held on December 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Commission considered all the factors required under California Government Code Section 56425; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The Commission hereby accepts the City of Redding Municipal Review and Sphere of Influence update, incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. The Commission, as the lead agency, finds the sphere of influence update is exempt from further review under the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations, Chapter 3 CEQA Guidelines, Section 15061(b)(3).

- 3. The Commission, pursuant to Government Code Section 56425, makes the written statement of determinations included in the SOI update, hereby incorporated by reference.
 - a. Present and planned land uses. The City of Redding is an urban community with a population just over 90,000. The City has developed a General Plan and Zoning Ordinance to address the type of land uses compatible for a city of its size. Uses include residential of various densities, with some more rural residential, commercial, and industrial designations.
 - Present and probable need for public facilities; adequacy of services. The City of Redding was incorporated in 1887 and services are considered adequate and ongoing.
 - c. Present capacity of the public facilities and adequacy of public services that the agency provides or is authorized to provide. These services are still under development and can be considered adequate. The City has the capacity to provide existing levels of service to areas within the proposed sphere of influence, with extension of services tied to development of parcels.
 - d. Existence of any social or economic communities of interest. The City of Redding is located between the City of Anderson and the City of Shasta Lake in the Sacramento Valley. Redding is the largest urban city in Northern California and is a major commercial and industrial center.
 - e. Present and probable needs of disadvantaged unincorporated communities (DUCs) within the area. The City of Redding is surrounded by unincorporated territory coterminous with its current SOI.
- The Executive Officer shall revise the official records of the Commission to reflect this Sphere of Influence Update.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED The Municipal Service Review and Sphere of Influence update of the City of Redding is hereby approved and incorporated herein by reference as presented on the attached map noted as Exhibit A.
