## NOTICE OF PROTEST PROCEEDING HEARINGS

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that two (2) Protest Proceedings will be held by the Shasta Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) Executive Officer, on Tuesday, November 29, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. at the Shasta Community Services District (CSD) Fire Station #56 located at 10644 High St, Shasta, California, to hear and receive any oral or written protests, objections, or evidence which are made, presented, or filed regarding the following:

**HEARING #1: Shasta CSD Fire Services Divestiture and Successor Agency Designation**  
**HEARING #2: Shasta Fire Protection District (FPD) Formation**

Previously, the Shasta LAFCO Commission approved the above listed projects according to determinations set out in Resolutions 2022-08 and 2022-14 on October 6, 2022, subject to conducting hearings to receive any protests filed against the Commission's action. These resolutions as well as the complete application, map and relevant information is on file and available for public viewing on the Shasta LAFCO website at <http://shastalafco.org/applications/current-projects>, in the Shasta LAFCO office located at 999 Mission De Oro Drive, Suite 106, Redding, CA, 96003, or, via e-mail, at [eo@shastalafco.org](mailto:eo@shastalafco.org).

These protest proceeding hearings are for the purpose of receiving protests from affected landowners and/or registered voters within the approved Shasta CSD divestiture and Shasta FPD formation area. Protest hearings are typically conducted to determine whether proposals would be confirmed, terminated, or subject to an election based on the number of valid written protests received. If the CSD divestiture /successor agency designation receives 50% or more valid protests, it will be terminated, and the second hearing will be cancelled. If not, since the FPD formation is already subject to an election for majority voter approval and election of directors to serve on the new district board, only the protest threshold for termination is applicable: Government Code Section 57075(a): *Terminate formation proceedings if written protests are received from 50 percent or more of voters/property owners residing in the territory.*

Any protests must be submitted before the close of the hearing and must be made by owners of land within the area and/or by registered voters residing within the subject territory. Protests may be mailed to Shasta LAFCO office listed above, or e-mail to [eo@shastalafco.org](mailto:eo@shastalafco.org) and must be received by November 24, 2022, or hand-delivered to the Shasta LAFCO Executive Officer or his designee at the Protest Proceeding. Only protests that are received prior to the end of the hearing on November 29, 2022, will be accepted as timely.
