AUTHORIZING A ONE YEAR TIME EXTENSION FOR THE FALL RIVER VALLEY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY AND DETACHMENT FROM THE COUNTY SERVICE AREA # 1 – SHASTA COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2021, the Shasta Local Agency Formation Commission, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," conditionally approved the Fall River Valley Fire Protection District (FPD) annexation of territory and detachment from County Service Area #1 – Shasta County Fire Department with conditions; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 57001 requires that a Certificate of Completion be recorded within one year unless extended by Shasta LAFCO; and

WHEREAS, a time extension is requested to allow the Fall River Valley Fire Protection District sufficient time to satisfy terms and conditions for the annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Shasta Local Agency Formation Commission as follows:

- 1. The time extension for the above referenced annexation and detachment is hereby approved.
- 2. The time frame for completion of terms and conditions and for recording a Certificate of Completion is hereby extended to April 1, 2023.
- 3. All provisions, terms and conditions of Shasta LAFCO Resolution Number 2021-05, dated April 1, 2021, shall remain in effect.
